What is this medicine?

RANITIDINE (ra NYE te deen) is a type of antihistamine that blocks the release of stomach acid. It is used to treat stomach or intestinal ulcers. It can relieve ulcer pain and discomfort, and the heartburn from acid reflux.

This medicine may be used for other purposes; ask your health care provider or pharmacist if you have questions.

How should I use this medicine?

This medicine is for injection into a muscle, or infusion into a vein. It is given by a health care professional in a hospital or clinic setting.\n\nTalk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. Special care may be needed.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at

once.\nNOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

What should I tell my health care provider before I take this medicine?

They need to know if you have any of these conditions:\n-kidney disease\n-iver disease\n-porphyria\n-an unusual or allergic reaction to ranitidine, other medicines, foods, dyes, or preservatives\n-pregnant or trying to get pregnant\n-breast-feeding

What if I miss a dose?

This does not apply.

Where should I keep my medicine?

This drug is given in a hospital or clinic and will not be stored at home.

What should I watch for while using this medicine?

What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible:\n-agitation, nervousness, depression, hallucinations\n-allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue\n-breast enlargement in both males and females\n-breathing problems\n-redness, blistering, peeling or loosening of the skin, including inside the mouth\n-unusual bleeding or bruising\n-unusually weak or tired\n-vomiting\n-yellowing of the skin or eyes\n\nSide effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome):\n-constipation or diarrhea\n-dizziness\n-headache\n-nausea
