**Drug Name: B COMPLEX/VITAMIN C**

**What is this medicine?**

B-COMPLEX VITAMIN with VITAMIN C (B-KOM pleks VAHY tuh min with VAHY tuh min C) is a multivitamin. It is mostly used to help provide good nutrition to people who need extra intake of these vitamins due to stress, renal disease, or other medical conditions.

**This medicine may be used for other purposes; ask your health care provider or pharmacist if you have questions.**

**How should I use this medicine?**

Take by mouth with a glass of water. May take with food. Follow the directions on the prescription label. This vitamin is usually given once a day. Do not take your medicine more often than directed. Talk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. Special care may be needed.

**Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once. NOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.**

**What should I tell my health care provider before I take this medicine?**

They need to know if you have any of these conditions: any chronic health condition an unusual or allergic reaction to vitamins, other medicines, foods, dyes, or preservatives pregnant or trying to get pregnant breast-feeding

**What if I miss a dose?**

If you miss a dose, take it as soon as you can. If it is almost time for your next dose, take only that dose. Do not take double or extra doses.

**Where should I keep my medicine?**

Keep out of the reach of children. Most vitamins should be stored at controlled room temperature. Check your specific product directions. Protect from heat and moisture. Throw away any unused medicine after the expiration date.

**What should I watch for while using this medicine?**

See your health care professional for regular checks on your progress. Remember that vitamin supplements do not replace the need for good nutrition from a balanced diet.

**What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?**

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible: allergic reaction such as skin rash or difficulty breathing vomiting Side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome): nausea stomach upset
